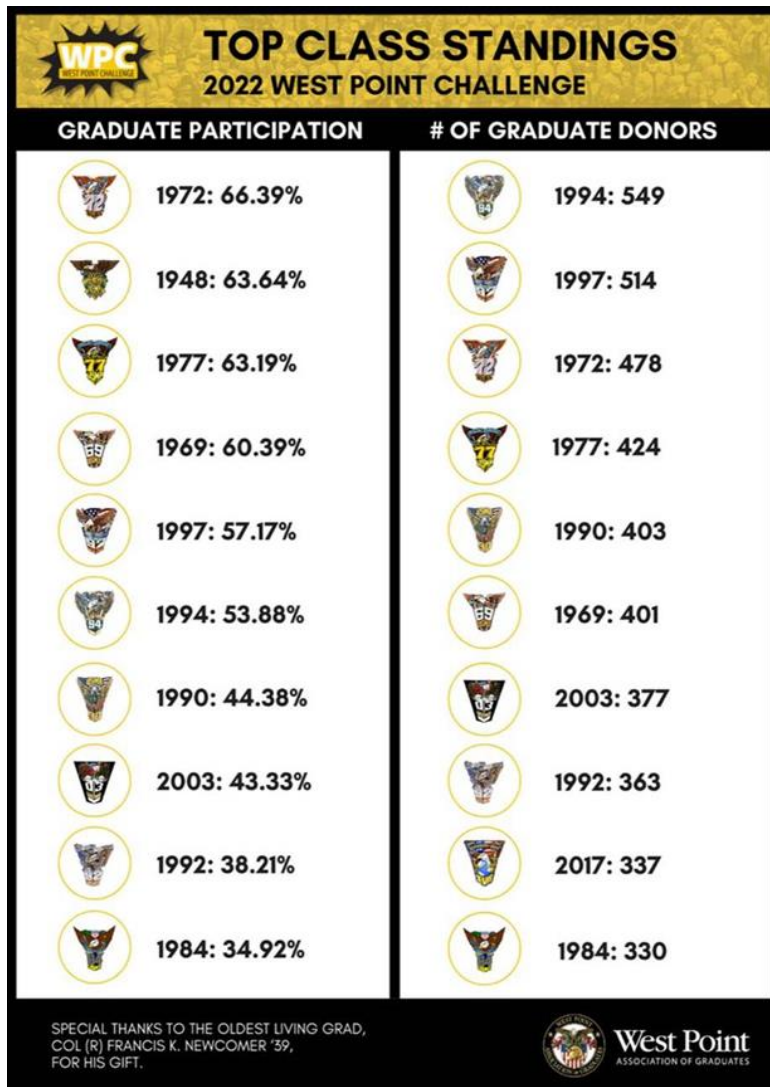
With gifts totaling \$4.4 million dollars, every part of West Point was impacted this week. Over 330 different funds received Margin of Excellence gifts.
